Computing

Information Technology: We will be continuing to look at what technology is and how to use a laptop. We have looked at the different parts of a laptop and will now continue to develop our own skills in using a laptop. Understanding of the world

<u>Art</u>

Sculpture: We will be looking at what sculpture is and the different types of sculpture. We will have a focus on Greek sculptures and be creating our very own masks. Expressive Arts and design – creating with materials

Design and Technology

Food and nutrition: We will be continuing our work on food and looking at how to make a cupcake Expressive Arts and design – creating with materials and being imaginative and expressive ELG

Religious Education

We will be recapping our learning on Christianity and the Church. We will also be looking at Hinduism this half term. We will be thinking about similarities and differences between religions learnt so far. Understanding the world – people, culture and communities ELG

History

Romans:

We will hear stories that help to build the foundational knowledge of the Romans. We will learn about the first emperor Augustus, emperor Hadrian and the life of Julius Caesar. We will learn how two of our months, August and July are named after famous Romans.

Understanding the world – past and present ELG

Geography

This half term we will recap our learning on the UK, testing our knowledge about the different facts learnt about each country. Our main focus across summer term is fieldwork where we will be exploring our school grounds using and developing the skills we have gained so far this year.

Understanding the world – The natural world ELG

Science

Energy:

We will be learning all about light and sound across the whole of the summer term. We will be thinking about common appliances that use electricity, understanding forces and thinking about the different sources of light and sound. Personal, social and emotional – managing self ELG

Physical Education

Kwik cricket and softball taught by a PE specialist focusing on throwing, aiming and batting skills. Physical development – gross motor skills ELG

English-Writing

Book – The Secret of Black Rock by Joe Todd-Stanton Writing outcomes: We will be writing a return narrative and a diary in role as the main character from the story. Year 1 will have a focus on different spelling rules such as using prefixes and suffixes and grammar focuses such as using different types of sentences and conjunctions.

English- Reading

Whole class guided reading with a focus on growing – linking to our previous science unit. We will be looking at a variety of non-fiction books about seeds and plants. We will be developing our vocabulary, fluency, inference and comprehension skills through a series of lessons based around the different books above.

Maths

REC: counting above 10, partitioning 10 and number bonds to 10, Mass, 3D shapes, odds and evens

Year 1: Place value above 20 -

 spotting patterns and making/writing numbers to 100, counting in 1s 10s and 5s, understanding 1 and 10 more/less

Multiplication and division –

- doubling and halving, representing and making equal groups, counting in 2s, 5s and 10s, repeated addition, arrays, sharing and grouping
