Dear Parents/Carers,

I wanted to take a moment to provide you with an update following the events on Friday.

As you are aware, there was a situation that required an emergency response. I want to reassure you that, at all times, the children remained safe. This was due to the highly effective policies, procedures, and risk assessments we have in place, alongside the calm and professional actions of staff. Our systems enabled us to respond immediately, contain the situation, and support the emergency services in their response.

Since Friday, we have carefully reviewed our procedures and are confident that they remain robust, appropriate, and effective. I have also been in communication with Cheshire Constabulary. While they are limited in the information they are able to share, they have confirmed that, for reassurance, there will be a visible police presence in the community this week including plain-clothed officers. We will continue to work closely with them to ensure clear and timely information sharing, and to maintain the highest standards of safety.

School will be open as usual tomorrow. We will continue to operate with vigilance, always ensuring that the safety and wellbeing of our children remains central to every decision we make. The police confirmed on Friday that they are satisfied for the school to continue operating as normal.

We will also be taking time to listen to and support any children who may have concerns, ensuring they feel safe, secure, and reassured whilst in school.

Finally, I would like to extend my sincere thanks to you, our parent community. We have received a significant number of emails expressing appreciation for how the situation was managed and how swiftly staff responded. Your kind words are genuinely valued by myself and the whole team.
