FAVSP Cross Country Event at Delamere Forest on Friday 22nd March 2024.

Dear parent / carer,

This year, we are attending the local schools cross country competition that will take place near Whitefield car park in Delamere forest on Friday 22nd March 2024. This event will begin at 10am and will finish at about 12pm. Each race is approximately 1km in length and each race is broken down into age and gender. If your child is born in September – February, they will be in the older race for their year group, if they are born in March – August, they will be in the younger race for their age group.

We are encouraging every child in Key Stage 2 to take part in this event. For those children who do take part, to thank them for their bravery and celebrate the fact that they had a go at this challenge event, we will be holding a reward afternoon on Friday 22nd March and ask that these children bring a change of 'party clothes' into school with them, ready for a celebration.

Children must ensure they come to school in their full PE kit on this day, including a plain white t-shirt, navy blue shorts, and appropriate shoes in order to be able to run around the field, as well as warm and waterproof clothing as children will be outdoors all morning. There is no toilet close to Whitefield carpark, and therefore staff will create a private area for children to be able to go in the forest if they need to. Please ensure your child brings with them enough water to last them the morning and a snack or two to keep them going. We will be having lunch when we return to school which may be later than some of the children's usual lunch time.

We would love to see as many parents and relatives supporting this exciting event as possible. We ask, if you are going to come, please do not take your child away from the Frodsham Primary Academy 'base' as staff are responsible for keeping your child safe on this day. We also ask that parents do not impede the finish line. Standing on the outside of the track would be much more useful in order to support your child and other children taking part in the event.

Children will be getting a coach to the event with members of staff from school. The coach will be leaving school just after 9. If you are coming to support your child, and want to take them straight to the forest in the morning, please specify that on the slip below. Your child must be at the forest for 9.40 so they can walk the track with the school beforehand. It is vital children are not late on this day.
